



Inspired by tin cans connected by string, Moshi Moshi combines this old-time technology with the leading edge of interactive light and sound technology. The geometric cloud and microphones beckon people to them with their glow. When people talk into the mics, their voices turn into light, travel to and through the cloud, and to another can. These two are then connected for a brief time.

Moshi Moshi can be rented as is or the technology can be modified, scaled, made into a different shape, or rebranded for a particular event or installation.

The second iteration of Moshi Moshi is currently in progress. It is a 20 x 30 foot cloud suspended 12 feet above bystanders. It includes additional functionality, including a mist machine, lightning effects, more interaction types for individuals and groups, persistent recording of conversations to be played at random times, and more.
